Dear Parents/Guardians,

If you are reading this message, then you received a phone call from our Superintendent indicating that we have a snow day. The Blizzard Bag is being implemented after the 5th allotted snow day. Please remember, today is a school day that will take place in your home. Choose one lesson from each of the subject areas provided to you in the Blizzard Bag. If additional snow days are called, you will follow the same procedure for day 2 and day 3 of the Blizzard Bag. Your child will need to return the work to the teacher upon returning to school; however, we understand that in some cases, parents have to make other accommodations for child care and will not be home. In this case, your child has up to a week to complete the work. Please keep the folder/information in a safe location so that it can be given to your child in the event that school is cancelled another day or two.

We are excited to offer this program, and feel it will promote a variety of engaging learning opportunities to our students. We are pleased that learning will no longer have to be disrupted during the winter months due to weather-related closures. The success of this program relies on *everyone's* involvement. Thank you for your support as we embark on this new path for learning.

Assignment Overview:
